INTRODUCTION

The Swapnajaya-Grassroots Young Women's Leadership Programme

The Swapnajaya initiative is a unique approach of ActionAid Bangladesh (AAB). The Young People team of AAB coined the idea to initiate a leadership program, designed to equip young women from the grassroots level all across Bangladesh, with the tools and techniques to harness the power of effective leadership and participate in the decision-making structure.

Objective

The program has an intensive learning and engagement model that aims to empower young women from grassroots levels, by providing them with leadership skills, training on digital literacy, and effective digital engagement to reduce the digital divide that is prevalent among marginalized young women.

The training has enabled the participants to harvest the benefit of leadership to raise voices against social stereotypes and create a powerful network of women leaders who can speak for their rights and influence other young women to be vocal.

Swapnajaya Cohort II

The Swapnajaya project began its journey in 2023. In 2024, Swapnajaya arranged its second cohort with 26 young women across Bangladesh. The aim was to train the grassroots young women across Bangladesh to experience strategic planning, conduct audience mapping, risk analysis, and budgeting, create detailed action plans, and disseminate their learning and leadership practices in their respective communities. In the process of field intervention, the participants identified a social issue that required attention in their respective communities and prepared an action plan to create awareness of such issues in their localities.

Location: Phulbari, Kurigram

Objectives:

- Prevent child abuse
- Create awareness on good touch and bad touch
- Engage multiple stakeholders (Teachers, Students, Guardians) to take collective actions

Number of people engaged: 150



- Through the awareness campaign, Swapnajaya leaders engaged with 150 children to decipher between good touch and bad touch
- Around 300 guardians and 20 teachers are now committed to taking collective action to prevent child abuse

Self-Defense Campaign On Preventing Violence Against Women

- A social cohesion protection team has been formed to monitor the situation and act collaboratively
- Young people have worked as a vanguard to protect the rights of religious minorities during the recent political instability

- Make community people more responsive and protect nature and biodiversity








- Several disaster-prone areas have been identified through FGD and community visits

- Young people and community members are now collectively raising their voices against deforestation and the protection of hilly regions


CONCLUSION


